PUBLIC PARTICIPATION AND CALL FOR COMMENTS ON THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST REGULATIONS, 2026

The Office of the Attorney General & State Department for Justice, Human Rights and Constitutional Affairs in conjunction with the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC) notifies stakeholders and members of the public that in exercise of the powers conferred by section 50 of the Conflict of Interest Act, the Attorney-General has developed the Conflict of Interest Regulations, 2026. The Regulations seek to outline the procedures, structures and systems for the prevention, management, detection and investigation of matters relating to conflicts of interest.
